

## ¿Adónde fuiste tú?

For today's homework assignment you are to imagine that you have just returned from the best theatre performance, art exhibit, or movie of your life! You are to write at least 60 words to describe where you went, what you saw, etc. By answering the questions from today's warm up drill in complete, Spanish sentences, you will be writing approximately 35-40 words. Therefore, you're going to have to embellish your account of what you did by using vocabulary from your chapter 10 vocabulary sheet and other verbs in the preterit tense in order to meet the 60-word requirement for this assignment. Obviously, you're going to have to a little bit of research to find out which event to attend by using search engines to explore what is going on in the various Spanish-speaking countries. You may, for example, choose to visit an art exhibit at the Prado Museum in Madrid, Spain. Or, you might want to look at a theatre performance at the Colón Theatre in Buenos Aires, Argentina; the choice is your own. Just make sure that what you are writing about is authentic. The research for this assignment should take no longer than 15 minutes. That way, you'll have the remainder of the hour to write about your visit. This assignment is to be typed in Spanish. We did review how to type Spanish accent marks this week. Consult your warm-up drills for a review if you need one. This assignment is due tomorrow - when we will be reading our papers aloud to the class. You will not receive a grade for the active listening assignment tomorrow if you do not bring your completed paper with you to class. This assignment is worth 20 points.
